CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS

YOUNG ADULTS

Because of my desire for growth and maturity in Christ through the opportunity of CAMP, I am in agreement and will submit to the following guidelines.

I fully understand that the violation of these rules may result in my immediate return home at my own expense.

1. Participants must dress appropriately and with Christian modesty in mind. Appropriate shorts will be permitted all day. This means shorts that are AT LEAST FINGER TIP LENGTH. No sleeveless clothing during worship, and no tight fitting apparel (i.e. tight dresses, mini-skirts, gym shorts, etc.) is permitted at any time. No clothing will be permitted that exposes your midriff area or promotes tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, racism, hatred or suggestive messages. Dress codes will be enforced by CAMP's administration.
2. Girls must wear one-piece swim suits or dark colored t-shirts over their swim suit. You need to have cover-up walking to the pool or lakefront area. Boys must wear a t-shirt at both the pool and lakefront area.
3. Attendance at all meetings and participation in team recreation **is required** for everyone.
4. Participants must not use personal vehicles for any reason, or leave campus without first contacting the CAMP Administrative office.
5. Participants are not allowed off campus. Once the participant is registered, they may not leave campus until checkout, unless a CAMP leader signs them out in the CAMP Office. No outside guests are allowed onsite unless previously authorised by CAMP's administration.
6. Scheduled times for room checks and curfew **must be obeyed** without exception.
7. During CAMP, participants must submit to the direction and supervision of our CAMP staff.
8. Participants MUST bring appropriate clothing, sport gears, spending money for Snacks, Bibles, and other essentials.
9. Fireworks, firearms, knives, or any other kind of weapon, alcohol, drugs, or any form of tobacco are NOT allowed. These items can be destructive to you and those around you. Also, DO NOT BRING skateboards, water guns, airsoft guns, video games, laser pointers, DVD players, tablets of any kind, laptops, or televisions. Also, paint is not allowed in the hotel rooms or cabins.
10. Any form of Public Displays of Affection (PDA) is not allowed. This is a week to work on your relationship with God.
11. Participants must wear nametags/badges at all times. There will be a replacement fee of \$5 if lost.
12. Ordering food to be delivered on campus is forbidden. In fairness to everyone, we will eat in the campus cafeterias. Snacks and Late Nite Bites will be available to purchase in the Snack Shack before lights out.
13. Visitors are NOT allowed. Anyone not registered must have prior permission from CAMP's Leadership.
14. Do NOT remove anything from the Cafeteria.
15. Cell phones are not allowed in classrooms or worship services. In order for cell phones not to be a distraction, students are encouraged to leave their cell phones in their rooms.
14. Lake Yale Baptist Conference Center facilities are to be treated with respect. **Any damage to a particular hotel room or cabin will be charged to all participants/students booked in that room or cabin.**
