STATE BOARD OF MISSIONS
(96 Members)

During the annual meeting of the Florida Baptist State Convention in November 2018, messengers approved Bylaw revisions which changed the geographical makeup of the State Board of Missions from an associational basis to a regional basis. Beginning in November 2019, the Board will be composed of members elected by the Florida Baptist State Convention from within the bounds of each of the six ministry regions. The regional distribution of Board members is to be made on the following basis of church membership as recorded in the annual statistical report for the prior year: (1) One Board member for 1-10,000 church members which shall increase by one for each additional 10,000 church members or portion thereof; (2) Total membership on the Board shall be no more than 99 members and no less than 90; (3) No ministry region may be permitted more than 22 elected Board members; (4) Each cooperating association shall be represented by a minimum of one member from one of its cooperating churches; (5) No association may be permitted more than five Board members; (6) At least one elected Board member shall come from a church affiliated with the FBSC as a Church-at-Large; (7) In no instance will more than six elected Board members come from churches affiliated with the FBSC as a Church-at-Large, with no more than two Church-at-Large representatives coming from any one of the six ministry regions.
