Two Ways to Use Openings in Conversation to Share Christ with Students


- 1. Passive Waiting for the conversation to open

Write the verse on the board and read it aloud. 2 Point out and recite the word darkness. 2 Turn off the lights in your classroom to communicate the meaning of darkness. 2 Turn on the flashlight or light the candle to communicate the meaning of light ? Recite the word light. ? Gesture/mime to communicate that God is light—that He is the Light in our darkness. 2 Have students recite the verse with you. 2 Distribute copies of the verses in the students' languages. Pray.
