FLORIDA BAPTIST STATE CONVENTION COMMITTEE ON NOMINATIONS

REPORT 2019

The Committee on Nominations of the Florida Baptist State Convention presents the following report for consideration and action by the Florida Baptist State Convention, November 11-12, 2019.

Persons listed in the sections "Nominees for Election" are being recommended by the Committee on Nominations for election by the state convention.

Names listed in the shaded areas are for **information only**. These members are currently serving and are not subject to action by the convention in the year 2019.

Additionally, this is the first year since the convention adopted the new State Board of Missions regional representation model at the 2018 annual meeting. The committee has worked diligently to move the convention towards this model of representation. However, it has been the desire of the committee to allow members currently serving as a member of the State Board of Missions the opportunity to complete all terms of service that they would have otherwise been eligible for and not to ask anyone to leave service early based on the change in the bylaws. The committee expects that all exceptions should resolve in the next 1-2 years based on the completion of terms. The committee has footnoted this report to be abundantly transparent where any exceptions to the bylaws have been recommended.

STATE BOARD OF MISSIONS (99 members)¹

The State Board of Missions is composed of members elected by the Florida Baptist State Convention from within the bounds of each of the six ministry regions. The regional distribution of Board members is to be made on the following basis of church membership as recorded in the annual statistical report for the prior year: (1) One Board member for 1-10,000 church members which shall increase by one for each additional 10,000 church members or portion thereof; (2) Total membership on the Board shall be no more than 99 members and no less than 90; (3) No ministry region may be permitted more than 22 elected Board members; (4) Each cooperating association shall be represented by a minimum of one member from one of its cooperating churches; (5) No association may be permitted more than five Board members; (6) At least one elected Board member shall come from a church affiliated with the FBSC as a Church-at-Large; (7) In no instance will more than six elected Board members come from churches affiliated with the FBSC as a Church-at-Large, with no more than two Church-at-Large representatives coming from any one of the six ministry regions.
