Across the state of Florida and throughout North America, God is continuing his work through the body of believers gathered together as the local church; all undergirded by faithful prayer and financial support.

- In the past year 69 church planters, including 47 multiethnic pastors, have been commissioned through the SEND Network Florida partnership.
- Across North America, 714 congregations have been planted this past year.
- Older churches are experiencing revival and revitalization as the Spirit of God breathes fresh life on His people.

Located just south of St. Augustine, Moultrie Baptist Church has shared the gospel faithfully in their community for four decades but by 2018 the congregation was in decline.

Change was needed and Pastor Johnny Weldon began praying for God to burden their hearts for the community. "Together we make a difference" is their new tag line as they aspire to become a multi-generational, multiethnic, and multiplying people on mission.

Financial gifts through the Cooperative Program help make revitalization efforts like these possible throughout the state.

Thankfully, Send Relief teams have been delivering food boxes to these families and sharing the gospel with refugees in need of hope.


