100 Years of Cooperative Program

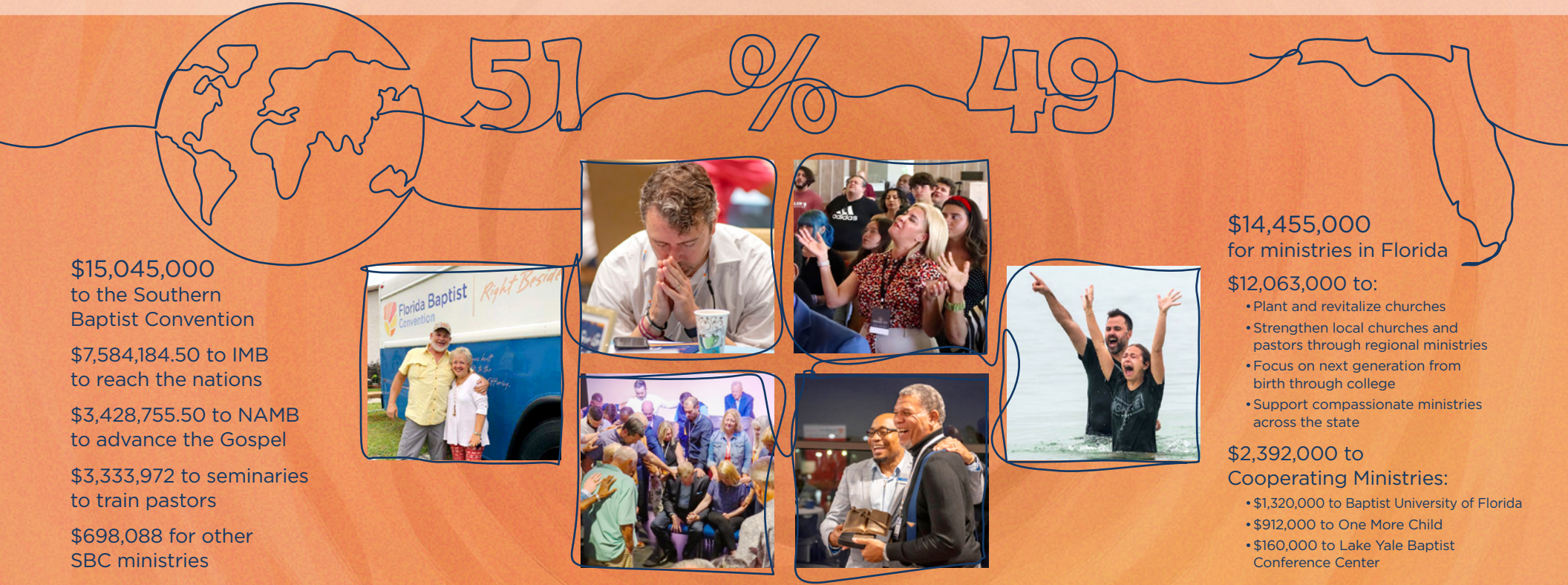
