Title: Minister of Students

Personal Qualifications:

- Able to express a call to ministry and demonstrate a mature walk with Christ.
- Be in doctrinal agreement with the Baptist Faith and Message 2000
- Bachelor's Degree required; seminary degree preferred

Overview:

The Minister of Students:

- Will lead, shepherd, and manage all aspects of student-aged programming for students from 6th through 12th grade at Pine Terrace Baptist Church.
- Is responsible for the provision and facilitation of a Christ-centered Christian educational program for middle school and high school students.
- Is required to promote evangelism, fellowship, worship, and discipleship by planning, promoting, evaluating, conducting, and coordinating all student activities in the church.
- Should demonstrate a passion for ministering to students, parents, and adult ministry partners.
- Is responsible for directing the spiritual formation of students to help them have an authentic faith in Jesus Christ.

Duties:

- Recruit and develop a student ministry leadership team consisting of adults and interns to plan and staff weekly programs and special events.
- Develop and lead the student ministry in a gospel-centered outreach and discipleship strategy that is consistent with the values and mission of Pine Terrace Baptist Church.
- Plan and execute biblically accurate, culturally relevant, and high energy programming for the spiritual growth of middle and high school students. This may include (but is not limited to) retreats, Disciple Now conferences, summer camps, fellowships, mission trips, etc.
- Lead in planning, organizing, and conducting fundraising endeavors on behalf of student ministry activities.
- Develop and maintain consistent and effective methods of communication with students, families, volunteers, and assistants in all phases of ministry.
- Consistently and purposefully visit middle and high school campuses to develop relationships with students, parents, and faculty members.
- Prepare yearly budget for Student Ministry and submit to Finance Committee
- Make hospital and bereavement visits as needed with special attention to students and their family
- Conduct Wednesday night student worship

- Work with Senior Pastor, church staff and other program and ministry leaders in planning a calendar of activities
- May assist or lead in the observances of church ordinances
- May assist at weddings, funeral and church ceremonies as requested
- Remain informed of current trends in student education.
- Assume all other responsibilities as assigned by the Senior Pastor
