- Meet with, counsel, and discuss special health and caring needs, or end-of-life issues with individuals and family members.
- Constantly influence seniors to continue in a strong, fresh, and growing walk with Jesus Christ through group activities and meeting with them personally.
- Maximize all opportunities to lead seniors to saving faith in Jesus Christ whatever the activity or circumstances.
- Lead seniors to be personally involved with outreach activities and evangelistic mission activities and mission trips. Lead them also to be fully engaged in the broader life of the congregation, in regular activities and special Hardee County-wide and other outreaches.

- Give appropriate leadership and direction to Church Leadership regarding ministry to Senior Adults.
- Perform any other duties as assigned by the Senior Pastor.
