50 Days of Prayer, from Resurrection to Pentecost

I am convinced that God is preparing us for a strong Biblical move of His Spirit to glorify Jesus Christ and spread His Gospel and Mission with His church. Are you **ready? Are you going to do your part?**

These **50 days of prayer, from Resurrection to Pentecost,** will be a key and convincing part of those steps of faith.

We have the privilege and opportunity to be part of a movement **together** where God is bringing a personal renewal and to the churches, as well. This movement is fashioning great expectation of what He will do to refocus us on His Mission of seeing lives reached for Christ. But it always begins with a brokenness and surrender of consecrating lives, marriages, youth, men, women, and churches for His glory.

The past few months have been filled with expressions of this *spiritual unity* along with personal growth of prayer and churches in this beautiful spirit of revival.

We are seeing that desire come true with the prayer movement throughout Florida where every week we see united expressions of this movement. Historic movements of prayer and revival always began with that sense of discomfort and even despair. From that brokenness came periods of a remnant praying and others joining that pursuit until God worked. I thank God for all who are doing it in Florida and joining the prayer movement in its diverse expressions. God is glorified!

We are about to begin "50 days of prayer... from Resurrection to Pentecost" inviting each church to join in praying that God may continue to transform us from glory to glory. May that quest be one that renews, brings conviction, and challenges us to see our need for greater power from on high. Hence the power for whatever He wants to do within and through His church in fulfilling the Great Commission.

In these 50 days of prayer let us pray each week for:

- A personal renewal in His Word. Therefore, you will see daily Bible quotes for God's Word to speak to us. Nothing pierces and wake up the heart more than the Word of God. You can do this personally, as a family, or in prayer groups. Use the Word to pray that this truth is real for your lives and church.
- A deeper prayer life in our lives, families, churches, and Convention. They are not activities or amount of time but a move of search and perseverance in prayer. God develops the desire and ways to do it. But let's help each other in the many opportunities to do it together in the local church with what your pastor and ministries do in regional or prayer group meetings, and by zoom each week, in SPANISH only, with others in the state (see attached schedule by zoom of the State Prayer Ministry (MOPALIB)*. You can register at www.flbaptist.org/pray to be part of the Florida Baptist Convention prayer emphasis. If you send your email to FRamirez@FlBaptist.org includes you in the list of Hispanic prayers with all the monthly events and reasons.
- A personal and church revival in whatever God wants to do to bring conviction, confession, sanctification, edification, and sending to His mission.
- A spiritual awakening in those who do not yet know Him. Use this time to pray for your family, neighbors, co-workers, schoolmates, community, and others you face each day. But start with your list of contacts, those by whom you want them to know Jesus Christ. Pray for them and ask the Lord how He wants to use you to sow the gospel and testify to them. As a church, pray for neighborhoods with prayer walks, peace person searches, prayer connections for the needs of those who want prayer, and other ways through social media on the internet.

- A Great Commission Move: Every revival always led to in a greater vision for the world and what God has prepared around us for His harvest. Your family, community, city, county, state, native country, other cultures, and the world. The command and strategy of Acts 1:8 remains effective. But you have to start where God has put you. May the church pray and decide to mobilize where God gives them opportunity and open doors. Join us in praying for short-term missions in the state this summer, sponsoring Vacations Bible Schools (VBS), going on mission trips, preparing to go out on short-term or long-term missions in the name of Christ.
- Pray that God's call and churches will support the next generation to go on missions. This summer they will be able to go with IMB, SEND, in union with other churches or any other way that God directs them. Let's talk about how to support them in that process; There are contacts, resources, and opportunities for every church.
- ➤ Come to the Great Hispanic Celebration, August 4-5 of all Hispanic churches in this year's Fellowship guided by the new President, Pastor Manny Barahona, at Westside Baptist Church | 3711 Old Boynton Road | Boynton, FL 33436. There we will inform of what God has done and we will have many opportunities to pray, serve and do mission. There will be the IMB and NAMB mission agencies with the movements of planting and doing missions. Youth and young adults will have their missionary testimonies with the whole church of what God has done throughout the world with them this summer. And opportunities and next steps will be introduced to integrate into this move of Great Commission and Missions. Those days there will be beautiful fellowship and connections to what God is doing. Soon, information will be published on the web (www.flbaptist.org/espanol) with details.
- Pray and prepare to be part of the Florida Baptist Convention: There will be Evangelism and Missions the days before the event. We open with a Hispanic Celebration on <u>Sunday</u>, <u>November 12th</u> with all Hispanic churches of Florida. We will continue with the Annual Convention. It will be a glorious time so keep the dates, motivate your churches, and plan to take them to Lutz (Tampa) | Idlewild Baptist Church | in November. May God give us favor and grace to maintain unity in Christ and His Mission in Florida and beyond.

I thank God for your lives, pastors, church and this great Florida Baptist Convention. Enjoy this experience of Prayer, do it together as a family and church, express it with other believers and churches in your city, be part of "prayer concerts", and join in what God confirms you that He is doing. Go forward in faith that we will continue to be transformed from glory to glory by His Spirit for His purposes and plans through His church!

Spiritual revival is an extraordinary story of God's grace and love for His church. It is God leading His people into a desperate, persistent, steady, and growing search through prayer. It is God, in His great goodness, opening the windows of heaven to cleanse and sanctify His church and to lead it again in the mission to which it has been sent. And then God finishes this experience by awakening lost sinners and bringing them into His kingdom.

Richard Owen Roberts describes revival as "The extraordinary movement of God's Spirit that produces extraordinary results." God is always moving, but in times of revival His work accelerates dramatically. First, He revives His church, then provokes a spiritual desire among the lost.

In recent weeks, reports are coming in that multiple college campuses across the United States are beginning to experience similar movements like Asbury University's. In our state of Florida, as a byproduct of the COVID-19 pandemic, since March 2021 we are experiencing extraordinary time and movement of God's presence. It all started when the pastor of Resurrection Baptist Church (Kissimmee), Reynier Coro, challenged his congregation to start a "Morning Prayer" every day at 5:30 AM. Since then the gatherings continue from Monday to Friday without interruption. This initiative was joined by other pastors and churches from Central Florida. Later, hearing of the outcome of this prayer campaign, Dr. Tommy Green, Treasurer and Executive Director of Florida Baptist Convention (FBC), launched a challenge to all FBC-affiliated Baptist churches to a 396-day prayer campaign from December 1, 2022 to December 31, 2023.

News and outcome of this "spiritual prayer experience" spread across the state and more than 4,000 Baptists at "Prayer Summits" and "Prayer Concerts," in person at some 16 churches and virtually via Zoom, have joined inspired by God's call to prayer.

On February 1, 2023, the prayer ministry endorsed by the Southern Baptist Convention (SBC) the "<u>National Hispanic</u> <u>Baptist Network</u> (RNBH)" began with outreach to pastors in the United States, Canada and Puerto Rico.

So what are Hispanic Baptist pastors and leaders in the state of Florida doing?

We are not going to find this simply in a specific physical place. We have to live it in a very special spiritual place... in our hearts! God's Word says in Luke 11:13 "If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!" (NIV)

During the Great Revival of 1904-1905, London's journalists asked an employee of the railway line that carried them to Wales, "Where is the revival? We have come to cover the news!" The man put his right hand on his chest and replied, "Here it is... in my heart!"

It is my prayer and my desire that this "Prayer Guide: 50 Days from Resurrection to Pentecost" will help us live and fill our hearts with a real "spiritual revival." I pray that the Holy Spirit will enable and impel us4 to fulfill the Great Commission given by our Lord Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:18-20).
