## CHILDREN & YOUTH (0yrs-18yrs still in high school) CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS-2025

(All students attending the Haitian Family Camp MUST read and sign this form!)

Because of my desire for growth and maturity in Christ through the opportunity of CAMP, I am in agreement and will submit to the following guidelines. I FULLY UNDERSTAND THAT THE VIOLATION OF THESE RULES MAY RESULT IN MY IMMEDIATE RETURN HOME AT MY OWN EXPENSE.

- Participants must dress appropriately and with Christian modesty in mind. Appropriate shorts will be permitted all day. This means shorts that are AT LEAST FINGERTIP LENGTH. No sleeveless clothing during worship, and no tight-fitting apparel (i.e. tight dresses, mini-skirts, gym shorts, etc.) is permitted at any time. No clothing will be permitted that exposes your midriff area or promotes tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, racism, hatred, or suggestive messages. Dress codes will be enforced by camp staff and students' respective group leaders.
- 2. Girls must wear one-piece swimsuits or dark colored t-shirts over their swimsuit. You need to have cover-up walking to the pool or lakefront area. Boys must wear a t-shirt at both the pool and lakefront area.
- 3. Attendance at all meetings and participation in team recreation is required for every student.
- 4. Participants must not use personal vehicles or leave campus without first contacting the CAMP Administrative personnel.
- 5. Students are not allowed off campus. Once the student is registered, they may not leave campus until checkout, unless an adult leader of their church signs them out from the CAMP Office.
- 6. Scheduled times for room check and curfew must be obeyed without exception.
- 7. During CAMP, participants must submit to the direction and supervision of our CAMP staff, especially those assigned to your particular housing area.
- 8. All students and counselors who will be staying in the cabins MUST bring with them Bible, pillow, pillowcases, bed sheets, towels, soap, shampoo, toothpaste/brush, appropriate clothing, Sleeping Bags, sport gears, spending money for Snacks. You do have linen packages available for rent at fee price.
- 9. Fireworks, firearms, knives, or any other kind of weapon, alcohol, drugs, or any form of tobacco are NOT allowed. These items can be destructive to you and those around you. Also, DO NOT BRING skateboards, water guns, airsoft guns, video games, laser pointers, DVD players, tablets of any kind, laptops, or televisions. Also, paint is not allowed in the hotel rooms or cabins.
- 10. Any form of Public Displays of Affection (PDA) is not allowed. This is a week to work on your relationship with God.
- 11. Participants must wear provided nametags at all times. There will be a replacement fee of \$5 if lost.
- 12. Ordering food to be delivered on campus is forbidden. In fairness to everyone, we will eat in the campus cafeterias. Snacks and Late Nite Bites will be available to purchase in the Snack Shack or other designated locations before the lights out.
- 13. Avoid using Cell phones in classrooms and/or during worship services. In order for cell phones not to be a distraction to other participants, it is encouraged to leave the cell phones in a safe and locked location in the rooms.
- 14. Participants are expected to follow all CDC guidelines and regulations due to Covid-19 and other contagious illnesses.
- 15. Lake Yale Baptist Conference Center facilities are to be treated with respect. <u>Any damage to a particular room or cabin will be charged to the church and/or group leader assigned to that room or cabin.</u>
